We have 2 new ways of making financial contributions to your parish now here at St Joseph's.

- On line by card: simply scan this code on your smart phone



- Also we now have a card reader in the porch on the way to the Hall where you can also make contactless payments for First and Second Collections or indeed make one off donations towards the Parish Debt which still stands at £150,000

Please be reassured, you will be able to continue donating using cash via the collection bags at Mass.

- Standing order, an instruction to your bank to make payments to your parish – (forms available from the parish website on the contacts page) and give to the Priest, put through the presbytery letterbox or put in a collecting bag. Don't worry about the parish's bank account details, the parish completes that part of the form as we have to have the form back anyway.
- Please Gift-Aid your donations if you are a tax payer: this enables us to reclaim the tax you paid on earning the amount you give. Each £10 turns into £12.50 at no cost to you. Forms for this are included on the Standing order forms at the back of church.
